Dear Panther Family,

You may be aware that there has been a gradual but steady rise of positive COVID-19 cases in Williamson County and this last week there has been a big jump on the Liberty Hill Jr. High School campus. There are now 13 positive cases with over 200 quarantined. Today, we met with the Health Services contact tracing team and have been in communication with the local Health Department on the new developments we're receiving.

Out of an abundance of caution and to minimize further spread among the school community, the Board of Trustees have made the decision that:

1. Liberty Hill Jr. High will temporarily move to 100% remote instruction for all students effective Tuesday, November 17th - November 20th. On-campus instruction will resume after the Thanksgiving break on Monday, November 30th.
2. Jr. High Staff will work from the campus, isolated in their rooms.
3. Provide additional deep cleaning and disinfecting of the Jr. High campus Monday evening, 16th 2020.

At this time, this does not affect any other campus as the numbers of positive cases remain low. We will continue to keep you updated on this situation.

Your student's health and safety is our top priority and we appreciate your understanding as we are all working with the best intentions. This is not a decision that comes lightly, nor is it ideal for anyone, but is necessary to maintain the safety of our students, staff, and families. Thank you for helping us protect each other and everything you do to support our schools.
