A. A-F System

1. This grading system will go to the campuses in January
2. Each campus will receive the letter grade in January
3. State says this will not be official

B. Three Domains

1. 70% is student achievement (HS includes CCMR, graduation, and other factors)
 - a) Approaches, Meets, Masters
 - (1) Masters gets us 3 points because we get a score in each category
 - (2) If we only focus on Approaches, we will be at needs improvement
 - b) School progress - take the better of the two scores
 - (1) Divided into two parts
 - (a) Making gains
 - (b) ECD students making the same gains as non-ECD students (equitable for all students)

2. 30% closing the gap

C. How are we getting points

1. Focus is on growth
2. 0 points, .5 points, 1 point breakdown

D. Closing the Gap

1. Looks at all population
